NOTICE OF HEARING TO THOSE WHO REQUESTED A HEARING

Proposed Rules of Minnesota Public Employment Relations Board Governing the Hearing of Charges and Appeals of Unfair Labor Practices Under Minnesota Statutes, 179A; Minnesota Rules, Chapter 7325; Revisor's ID Number R-04345.

To persons who requested a hearing. In accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 14.25, subdivision 1, the Minnesota Public Employment Relations Board (PERB) is sending this Notice to all persons who requested a hearing.

There will be a hearing. In the December 28, 2015 State Register, on pages 720 to 722, the PERB published a Notice of Intent to Adopt Rules relating to the procedures to be used for the hearing of charges and appeals of unfair labor practices under Minnesota statutes, 179A. The Notice stated that the PERB would hold a hearing on the proposed rules if 25 or more persons submitted written requests. We have received a sufficient number of requests for a hearing. The hearing will be conducted as stated in the State Register in the boardroom of the PERB's offices located at 1380 Energy Lane, Suite #1 in St. Paul, Minnesota starting at 1:30 p.m. on Monday, February 22nd, 2016.
