I can agree to everything you said -- EXCEPT FOR E-12. I will accept nothing less than \$ 550 million above the Base for the next biennium. It must provide no less than \$261 million for an additional 1½%/1½% on the formula. \$173 million for Universal Pre-K, half day, beginning in school year 16/17. \$20 million for Indian Education. \$1 million for MDE & BoT. \$25 million for Special Education. \$9 million for Head Start. \$4 million for North Side Zone/St. Paul Zone. \$8 million for Regional Centers. \$19 million for Q Comp. \$5 million for Teacher Workforce. \$5 million for Reading Corps. \$8 million for English Learners. \$12 million for Free Breakfasts Pre-K - 1st grade. The additional \$150 million above your \$400 million offer comes off the Bottom Line. Anything else you want, adds to this \$550 million, and also comes off the Bottom Line. If you agree to each of these sub-totals and this total for E-12, we have a deal on the Global Target (contingent upon our review of your Spread Sheet), and you don't need to come back tonight. If you don't agree, I don't agree to anything; and we need to start again tomorrow morning.
