INFORMATION MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: FY 1984 Allotments for the Developmental
Disabilities (DD) Basic Support and
Protection and Advocacy Formula Grant Programs

CONTENT: P.L. 98-107, Continuing Resolution, contained
funding authority for the Developmental
Disabilities Basic Support and Protection and
Advocacy Programs through November 10, 1983
at the FY 1983 annual level for both
programs. This Continuing Resolution
provided authority to fund at not more than
twelve (12) percent of the FY 1983 level.
Under the Continuing Resolution, the annual
funding level for Basic Support was
\$43,180,000 and \$7,320,000 for Protection and
Advocacy.

P.L. 98-139 provided funding for the DD
Program for the remainder of FY 1984. The
funding levels under this authority are
\$43,750,000 for Basic Support and \$8,400,000
for Protection and Advocacy.

Grant awards have been issued for FY 1984 as
follows:

- 1) The first award provided 12% of the
annual funding authority under the
Continuing Resolution; and
- 2) The second award provided full year
funding based on the annual funding
authority under P.L. 98-139.

Attached for your information are State tables showing distribution of funds for Basic Support and Protection and Advocacy under P.L. 98-107 and P.L. 98-139.

Prior to issuance of FY 1984 grant awards, the elements of the Developmental Disabilities Program formula were updated. Attached for your information are the Source Data used to update the formula for total population, adult disabled children receiving Social Security benefits, average per capita income, and "working" population.

Although the Developmental Disabilities Basic Support and Protection and Advocacy funding levels in FY 1984 are higher than FY 1983, the updating of the elements in the formula caused a shift in distribution of available funds. Individual grant awards which reflect an increase or decrease are due to changes in statistics used in updating the elements of the formula.


