CONTENT:

This memorandum sets forth the individual
allotments to States authorized by Public Law
99-178, as adjusted by Public Law 99-177, for
Fiscal Year 1986. This issuance supersedes the
promulgation set forth in the Federal Register,
Vol. 50, No. 61, Friday, March 29, 1985, at page
12652.

These allotments continued to be based on the
requirements in Section 125(a)(2) of the
Developmental Disabilities Act of 1984 (P.L.
98-527). The change in the dollar figures is due
to an increase in the Fiscal Year 1986
appropriations levels, as adjusted by P.L. 99-177.

These allotments continue to be based upon:

Statistical Supplement, 1983."

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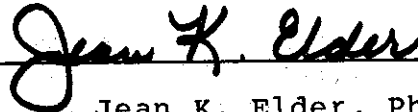
