

**CONTENT:** The attached table sets forth Fiscal Year 1996  
individual allotments to States administering the  
State Developmental Disabilities Councils and the  
Protection and Advocacy Formula Grant Programs.  
This notice is required because the FY 1996  
Labor/Health and Human Services Appropriation Act,  
P.L. 104-134, enacted an amount different from the  
Fiscal Year 1995 appropriation for the State  
Developmental Disabilities Councils Program.  
Since the amount appropriated (\$64,803,000) was  
insufficient to hold States at the required level,  
allocations were computed based on the  
requirements of Section 125(a)(3)(B) of Public  
Law 103-230.

The amount appropriated in Fiscal Years 1995 and 1996 for the Protection and Advocacy Program did not change.
