Pursuant to the Court's September 4, 2020 Order, the Court's jurisdiction over this matter ended on October 24, 2020. ([Doc. No. 879.](#))

On December 7, 2020, the Court granted Defendant's Unopposed Motion to Return Registry Funds to the Minnesota Department of Human Services. ([Doc. No. 902.](#)) The Court's Financial Department issued the registry payment as ordered on December 18, 2020. On January 7, 2021, a representative of the Minnesota Department of Human Services emailed the Court's Financial Unit asking for an accounting of the registry account.

Based upon the status of the case and the Court being otherwise duly advised in the premises, hereby enters the following:

ORDER

1. The Court grants the Minnesota Department of Human Services' informal request and authorizes the Financial Unit for the District of Minnesota to release the registry account summary to counsel of record and to the Minnesota Department of Human Services.

2. The account summary for registry and non-registry accounts in this matter is attached as Exhibit A to this Order and shall be filed as a restricted document with access to the applicable parties in this case and is to remain restricted until further order of this Court. A record of each distribution is also available by reviewing previously entered Orders of Distribution on the docket.
