

## Proposed Baseline for Review

The 2015 baseline for Waiting List Two in the Olmstead Plan was based on the previous reporting system and cannot be used for direct comparison with current waiting list data. Now that a full year of urgency data has been collected, a new baseline is being proposed.

The proposed baseline is being presented to the Subcabinet for review at the May 22, 2017 meeting. If approved, the baseline will be incorporated into the May 2017 Quarterly Report which is being reviewed by the Subcabinet at the May 22, 2017 meeting.

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**WAITING LIST GOAL TWO: By December 1, 2015, the Developmental Disabilities (DD) waiver waiting list will move at a reasonable pace.**

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**Baseline:** In April 2015, there were 3,586 individuals on the DD waiver waiting list.

### PROPOSED BASELINE:

#### Proposed Baseline:

From January – December 2016, of the 1,584 individuals assessed, 719 individuals or 45% moved off the DD waiver waiting list at a reasonable pace. The percent by urgency of need category was: Institutional Exit (39%); Immediate Need (61%); and Defined Need (40%).
