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This report is a summary profile of the 1973 Residential Environment Survey. Included are histograms and tables to illustrate individual hospital standings, as well as statewide averages for mental illness, mental retardation and chemical dependency categories, for each Survey item.

Only staff responses are considered. (One staff person per ward completed the Survey ... all living units were surveyed ... with the exception of those having extremely transitory populations.)

Items have been categorized (see index).

For all "yes - no" type items:

1. percent of "yes" responses is shown; "no", "not applicable" and "no response" responses are not indicated.
 - a. Item from Survey is printed out: i.e., "Have you read the record of each resident you supervise?"
 - b. Percent "yes" responses by type-of-ward and by state-wide average are listed:

 - c. Institutions are ranked in four groups (0-25% 26-50% 51-75% and 76-100%) according to percent "yes" responses.

Therefore, for item "Have you read the record of each resident you supervise?", it is shown that 79% of staff raters on MR wards indicated "yes" they had, 91% of staff raters on MI wards indicated "yes", and 72% of staff raters on INB wards indicated "yes", giving an average "yes" response of 81% for all staff raters for all disability groups combined; it is also shown that at FFSH, MLSH, RSH, SPSH, MSH, WSH, CSH, FSH, and MVSAC between 76 and 100% of wards (raters) responded "yes", at ASH, HSH, MLC, and BSH between 51 and 75% of raters responded "yes", and at RSAC between 26 and 50% of raters responded "yes".

For all numerical items, tables are provided showing percents, ratios, and/or ranks, where relevant.
