Intent to Reallot Part C—Protection and Advocacy Funds to States for Developmental Disabilities Expenditures

AGENCY: Administration on Developmental Disabilities, Administration for Children and Families, Department of Health and Human Services.

ACTION: Notice of Intent to Reallot Fiscal Year 1993 Funds, pursuant to section 142(b) of the Developmental Disabilities Assistance and Bill of Rights Act, as amended (Act).

SUMMARY: The Administration on Developmental Disabilities herein gives notice of intent to reallot funds which are not available to the Federated States of Micronesia and the Republic of Marshall Islands (formerly part of the Trust Territories of the Pacific Islands) under the terms of the Compact of Free Association under the Protection and Advocacy program. Any State or Territory which wishes to release funds or cannot use the additional funds under Part C—Protection and Advocacy program for Fiscal Year 1993 should notify Bettye J. Mobley, Chief, Family Support Branch, Office of Financial Management, Administration for Children and Families, Department of Health and Human Services, 370 L'Enfant Promenade, SW., Washington, DC 20447, in writing within thirty (30) days of the date of this promulgation. This notice is hereby given in accordance with section 142(b) of the Act.

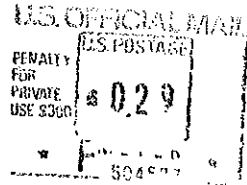
