DISCUSSION :

Amendments to the current Three Year State Plan (fiscal years 1998-2000) for each State should be submitted by the Developmental Disabilities Council (DDC) to the respective Regional Office by August 15. Budgets for the coming year, as well as material amendments, should be included in the amendments. There will not be any requirement for electronic data submission of the amendments at this time.


Under the Government Performance and Results Act (GPRA), we are required to report on our performance targets for future years. In compliance with that, each State DDC last year already submitted targets. If desired, amended targets for

fiscal year 2000 may be submitted to the respective Regional Office at this same date, and in the following areas:

- * number of adults with developmental disabilities who obtain integrated jobs
- * number of businesses employing persons with developmental disabilities
- * number of persons with developmental disabilities owning/renting their own homes
