SUBJECT : Requirement for Submission of State 1990 Reports

LEGAL AND RELATED REFERENCES : Public Law 100-146, Developmental Disabilities  
Act Amendments of 1987

CONTENT : By January 1, 1990, States are required to submit to their Governors, and, by January 15, 1990, the Governors to the Secretary, Department of Health and Human Services, their State 1990 Reports. ADD's Program Instruction PI-88-2 describes the specific State requirements concerning reviews, analyses, public forums and preparation of the final State reports.

This instruction provides guidance to States on submission of their 1990 Reports to ensure that State findings and recommendations are included in ADD's national report to Congress due April 1, 1990.

INSTRUCTION : State reports must be submitted to the Administration on Developmental Disabilities in Washington, D.C. on or before January 15, 1990. We request that a copy of each State 1990 Report be forwarded simultaneously to the appropriate OHDS Regional Office. If the required 1990 Report is not received by January 15, 1990, the State will be considered substantially out of compliance with the 1987 Developmental Disabilities Act Amendments.


A summary of State reports will be developed and transmitted by the Secretary to Congress by April 1, 1990.
