Designed for national and statewide policy leaders 5/1-2 day regional training events

 - public policy and the law
- b. Recruitment of Youth (who and where?)
 - how and where to look, how to invite and secure people
 - communities of color, rural and urban access, disability constituencies
- c. Individual Participation & Service Assignments (do what?)
 - assessment, interest, & abilities for service
 - community competencies and needs
 - customizing for breakthrough community roles
 - Task analysis for assignment skill building
- d. Group Inclusion and Team Building (peer identification)
 - seeing, feeling, and understanding each other as valued
 - "with" not "for"
 - interdependence in problem definition and solving
 - long term bonds and alliances
- e. Leadership Roles and Development (beyond self, new roles)
 - long term challenges
 - interdependence relationships in community
 - community building
- f. Accommodation, Instrumentation, and Adaptation
 - levelling the playing field for maximum contribution
 - strategies and technology to see, amplify, move, communicate, understand, and effect one's environment
- g. Pay Offs/Research/Evaluation (the benefits, efficiencies, and multipliers of diversity and inclusion in service to America)
 - what is important, how to count quality outcomes
 - how to customize this work for everyone
 - how to report and interpret what is important for policy leaders, staff, youth, taxpayers and the different publics
- h. Getting Help (figuring it out and doing it well)
 - How to find help near or far, who to ask, things to ask for
 - phone, computer, mail, visits on call
